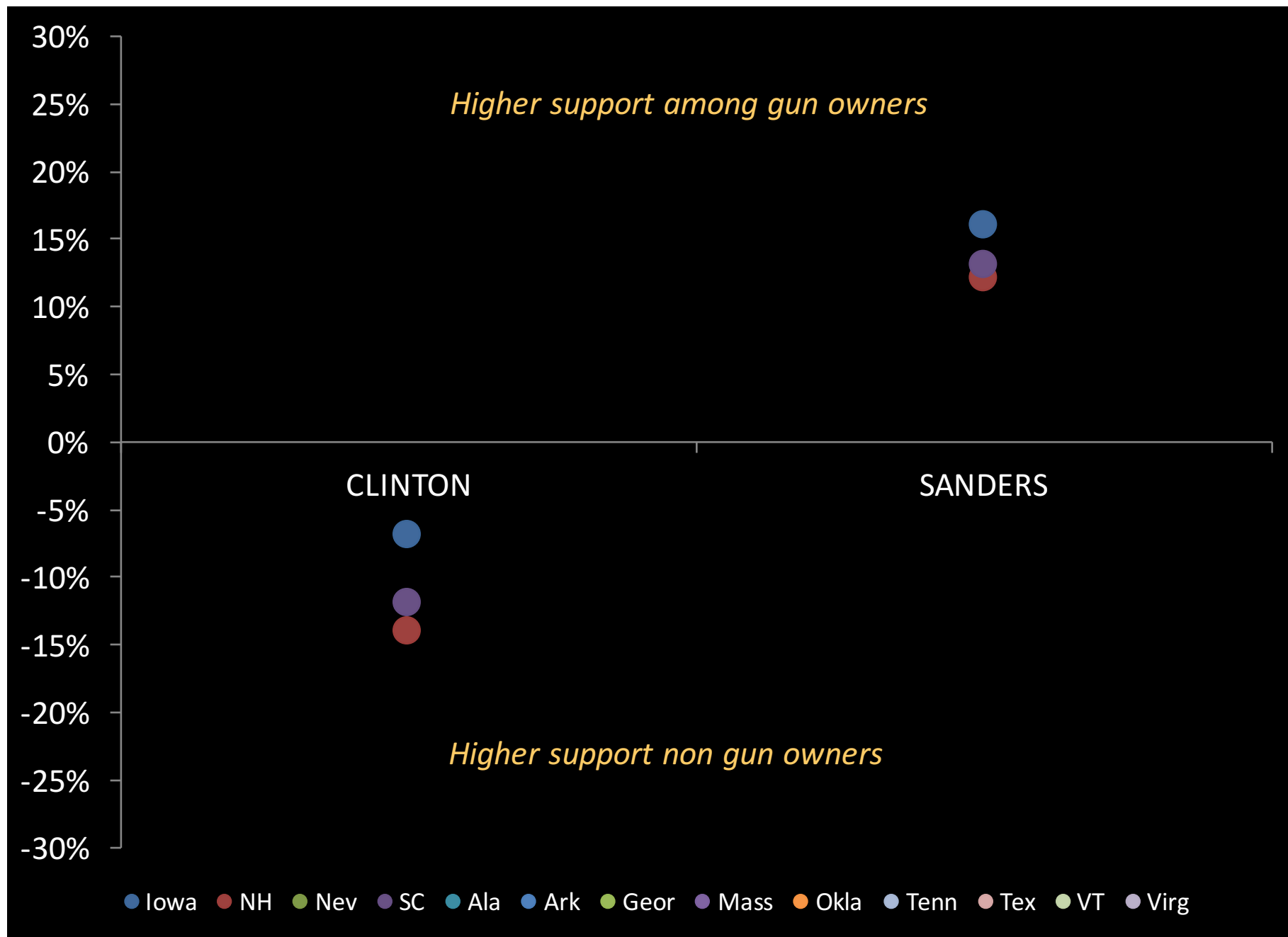


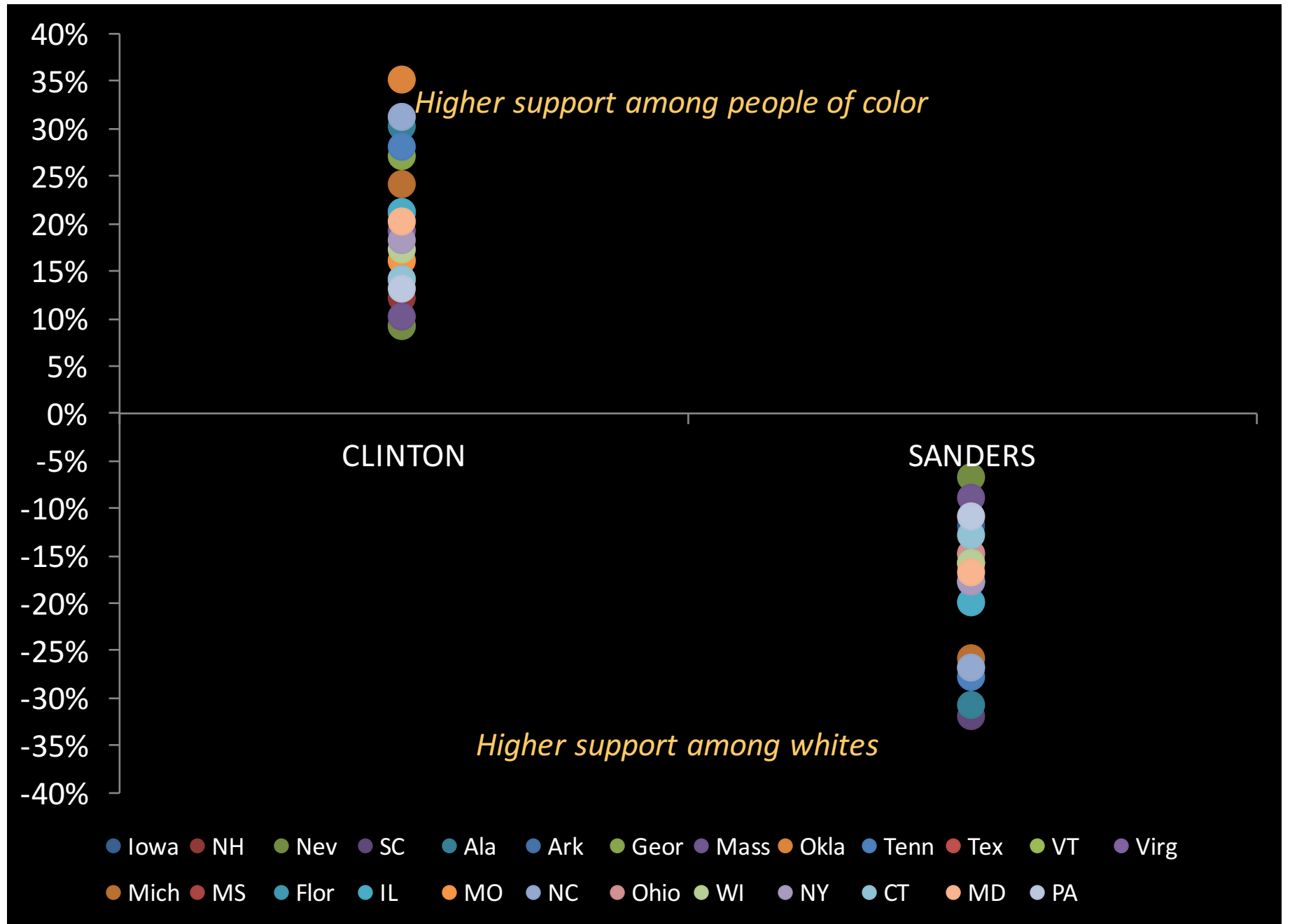
Average Vote Share, Caucus versus Primary States

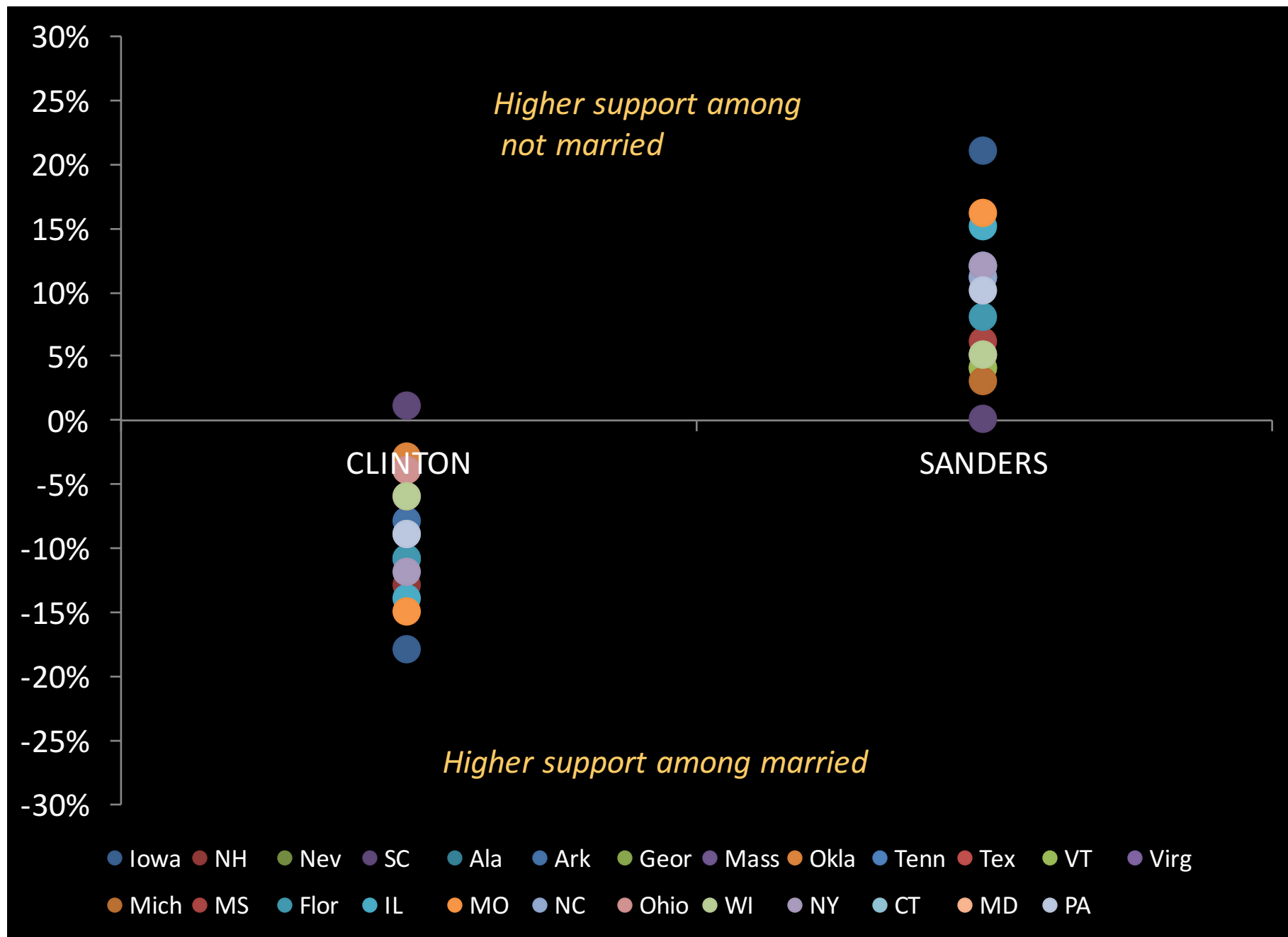


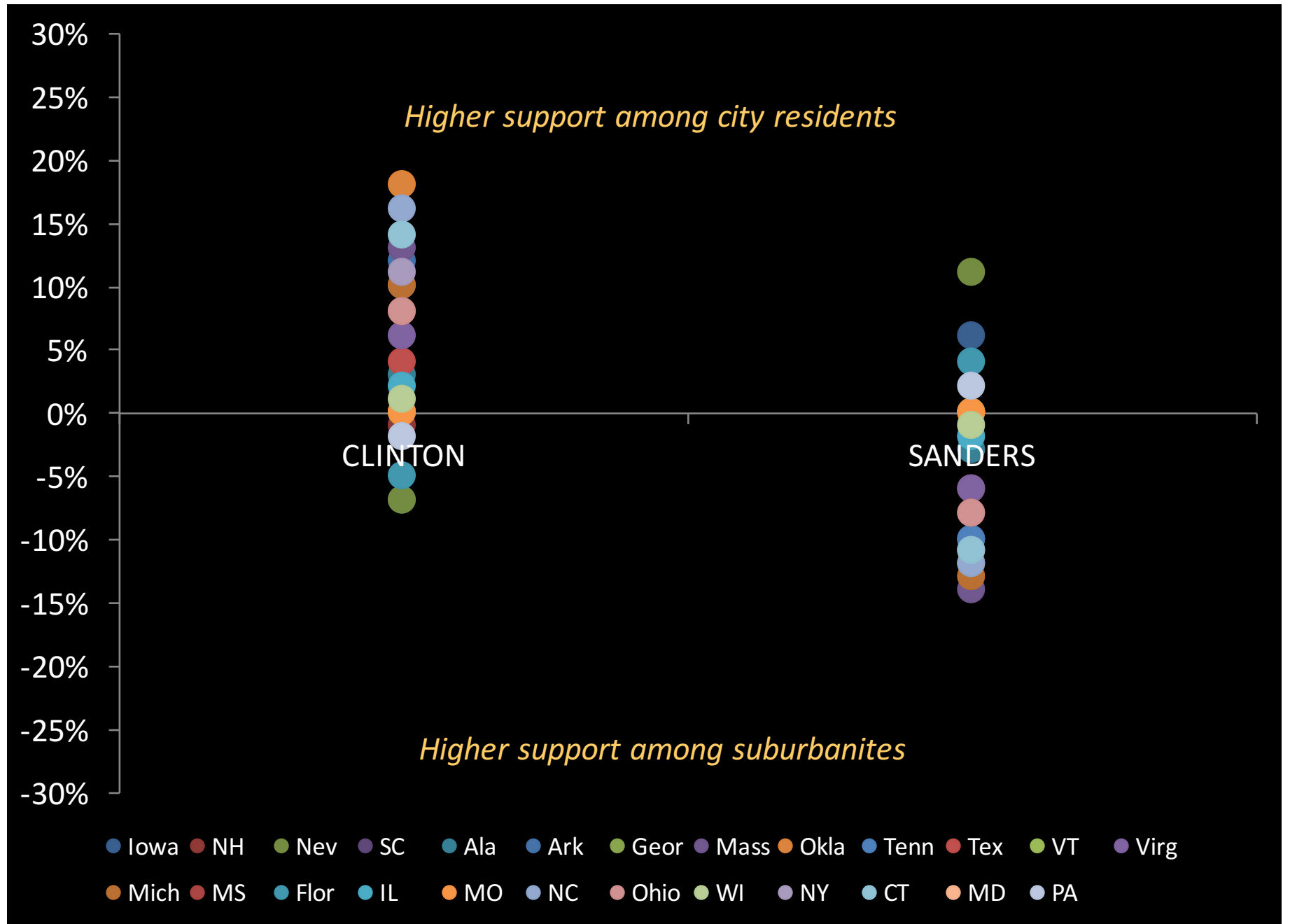


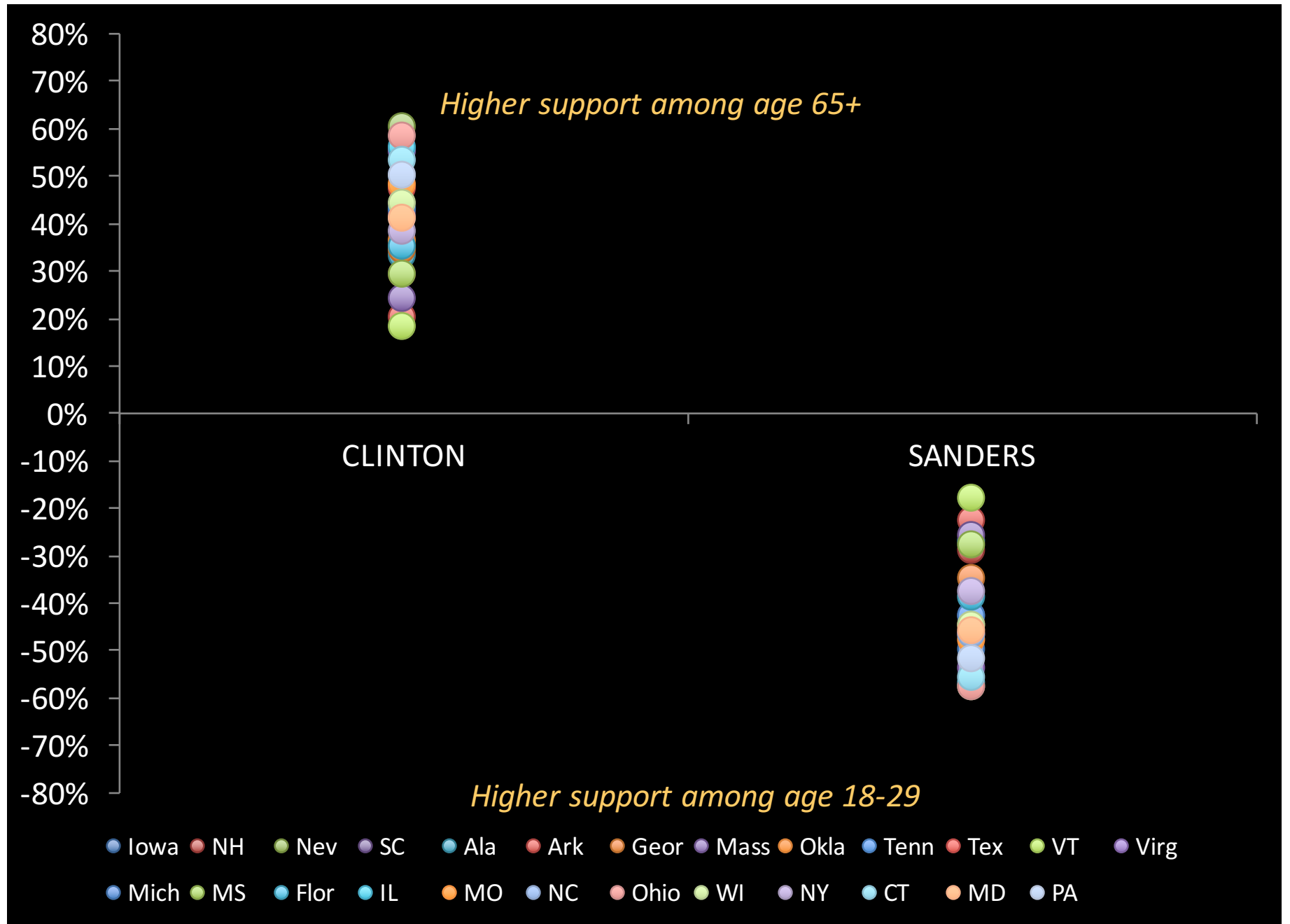


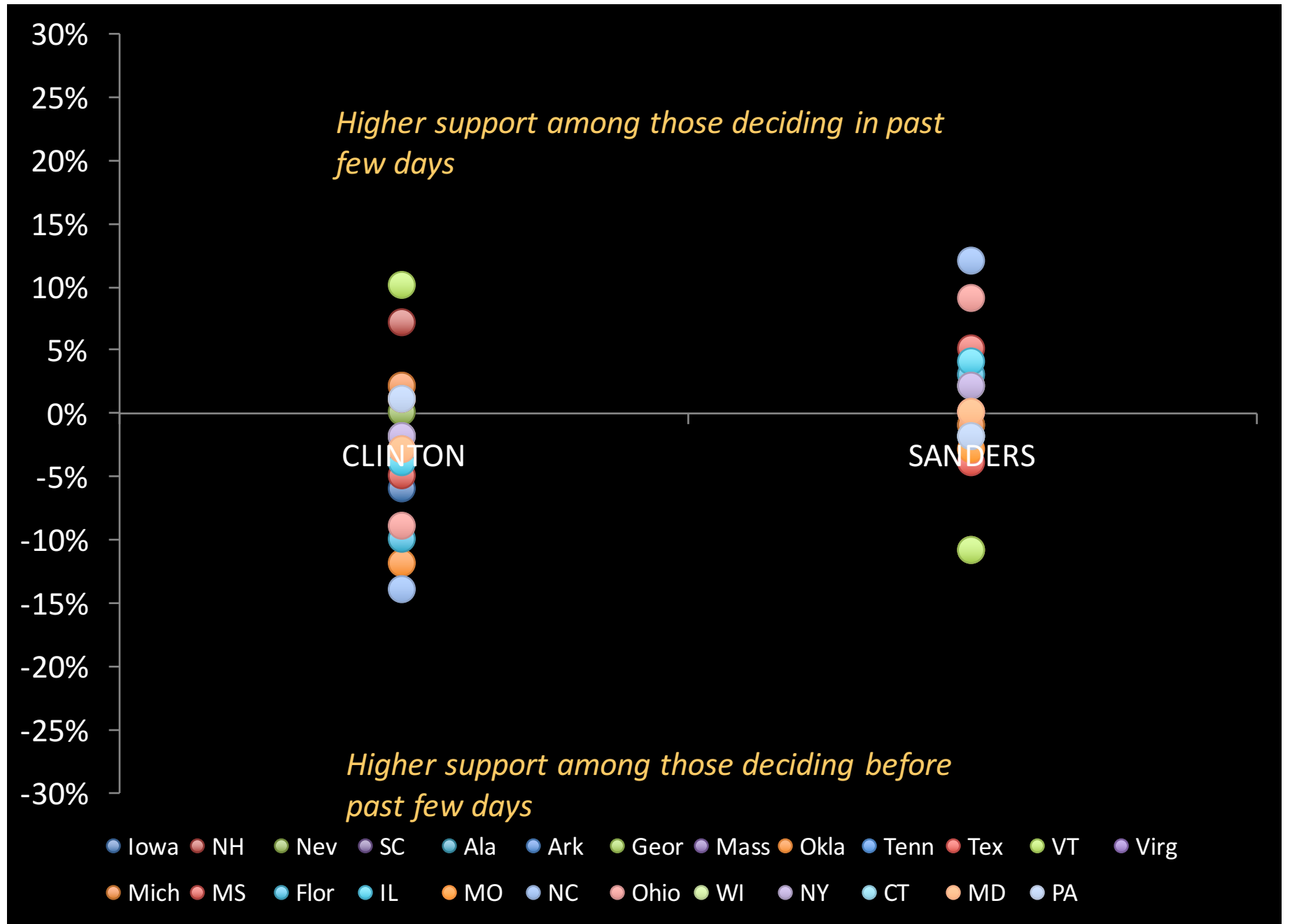


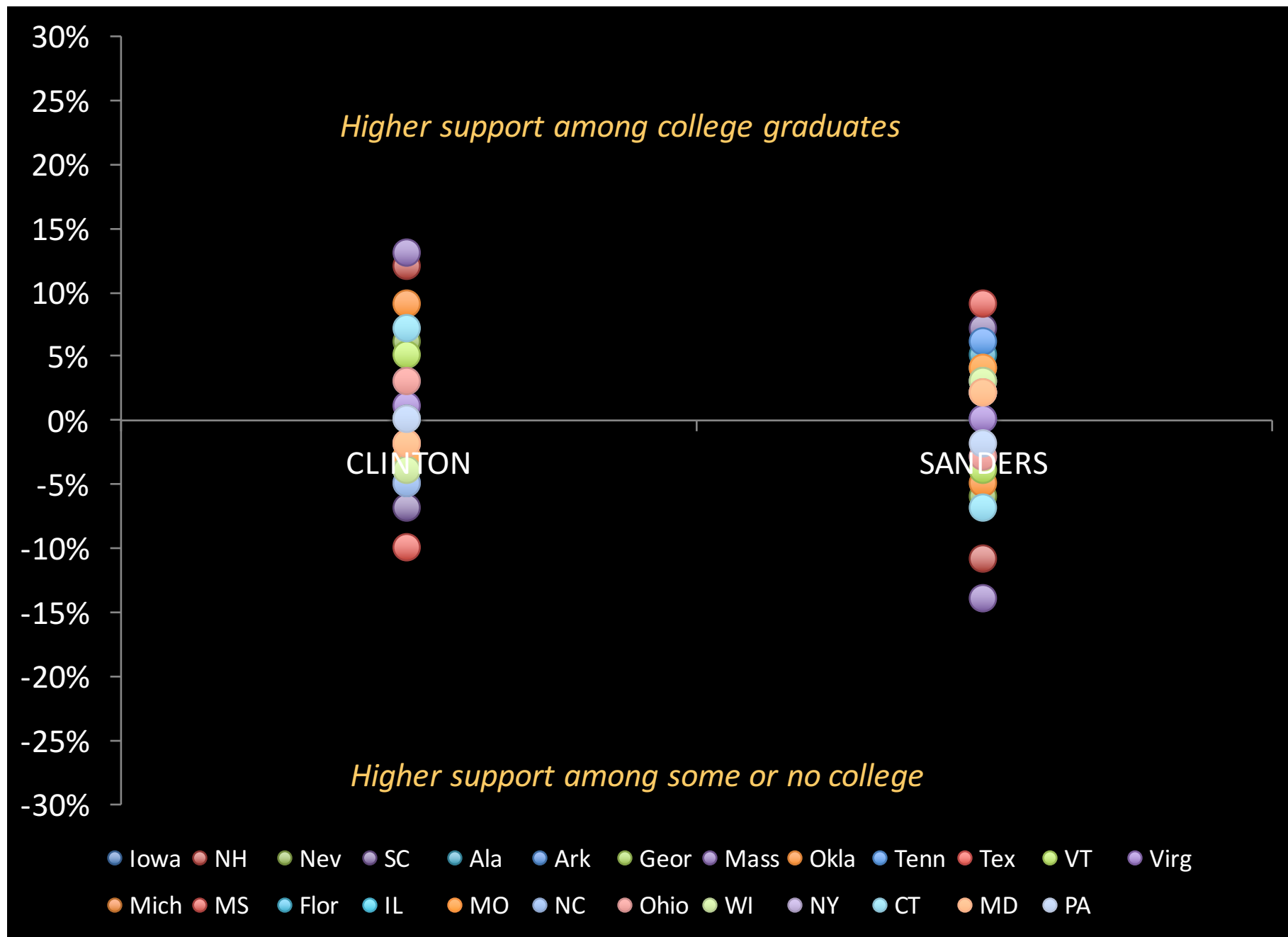




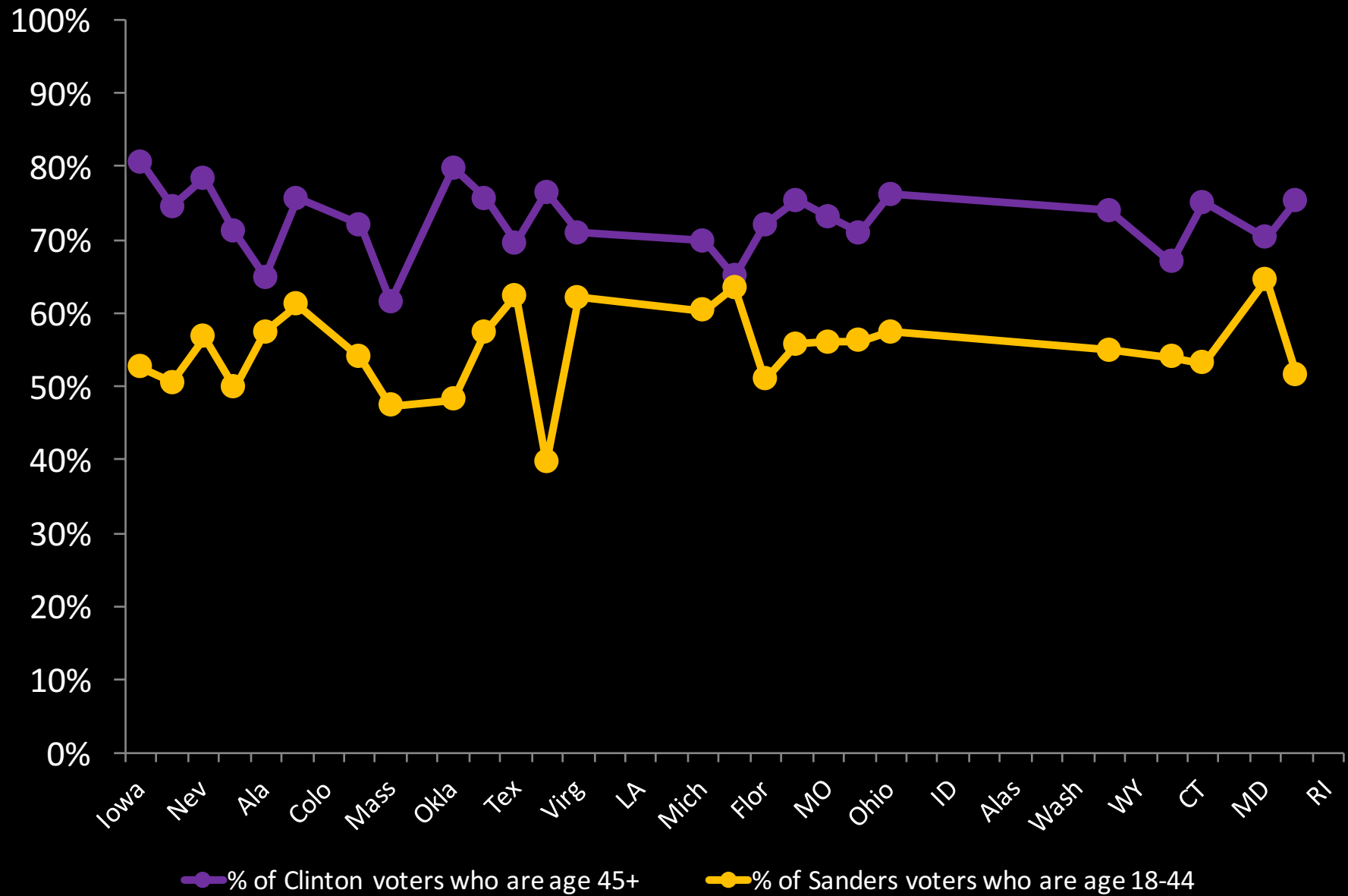


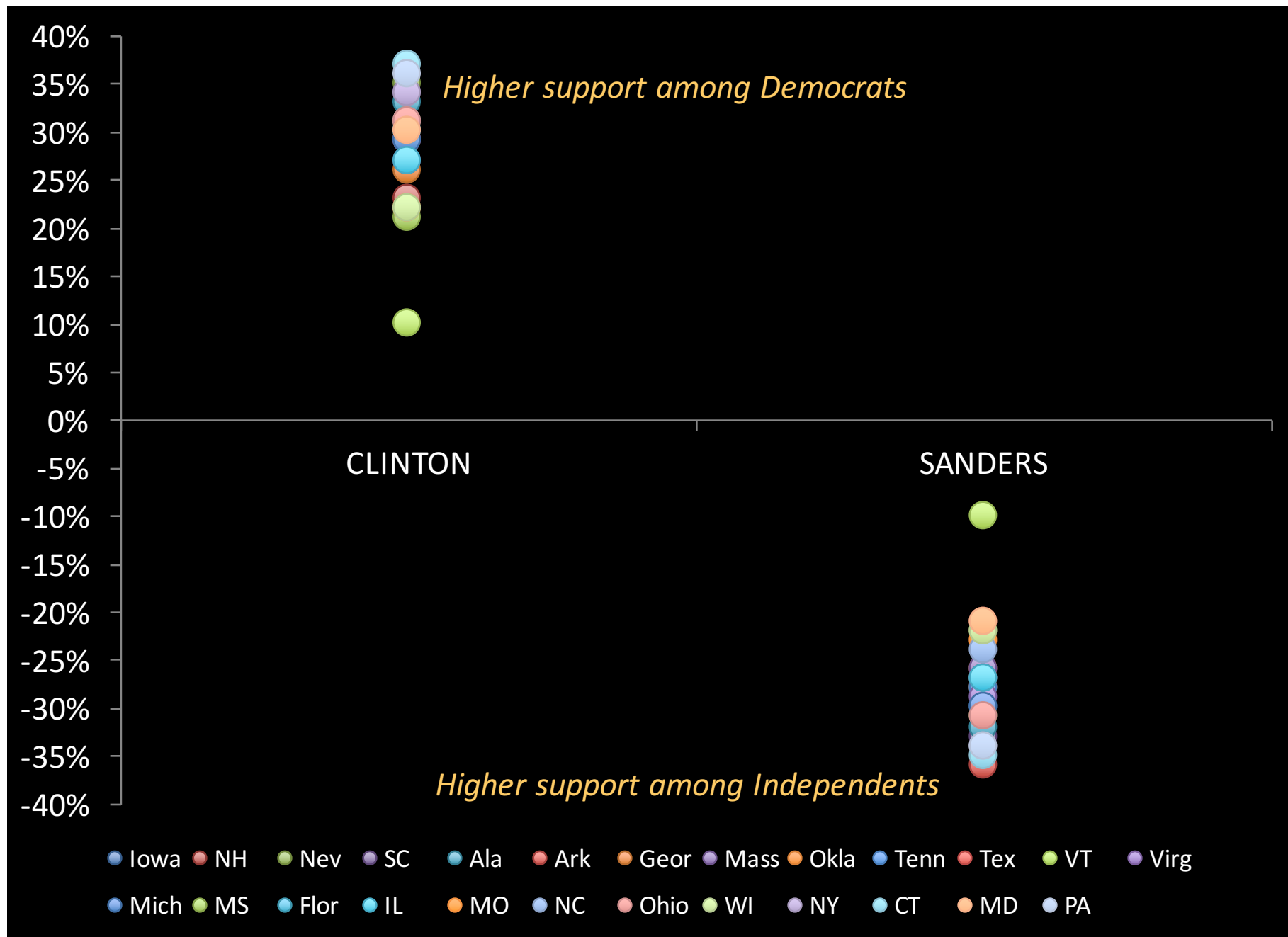




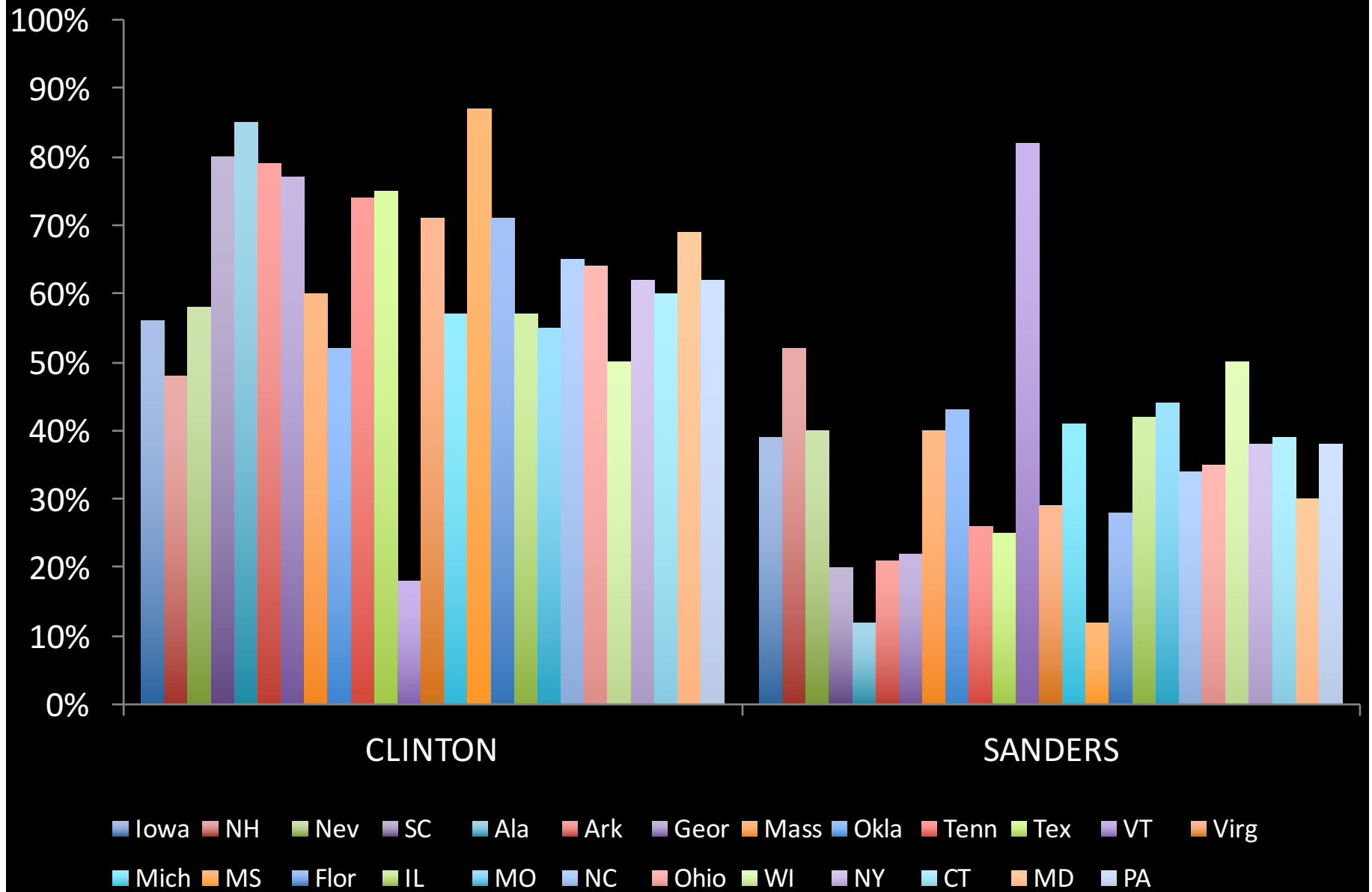


Age groups as proportion of candidate support

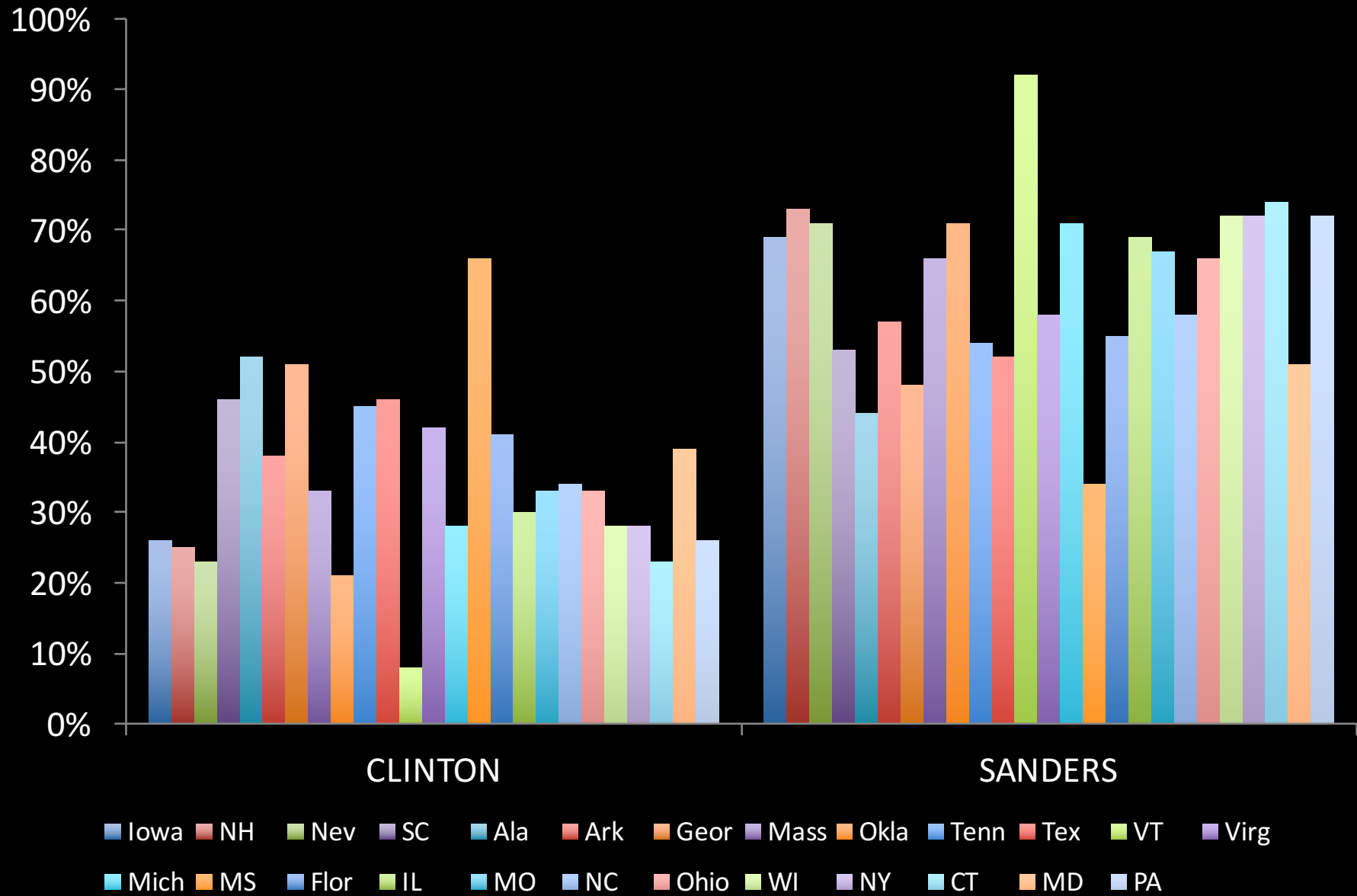


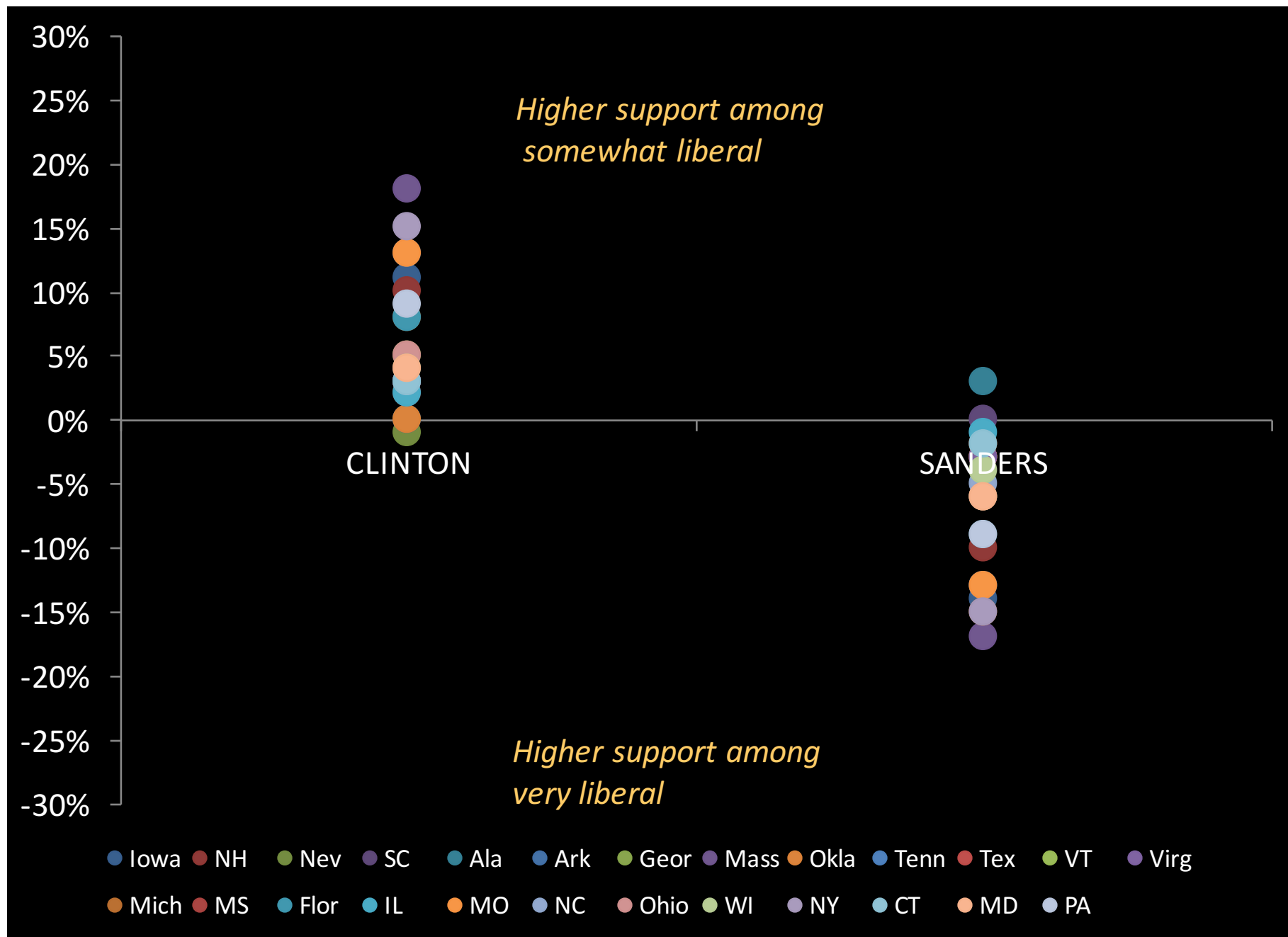


Candidate preference of Democrats

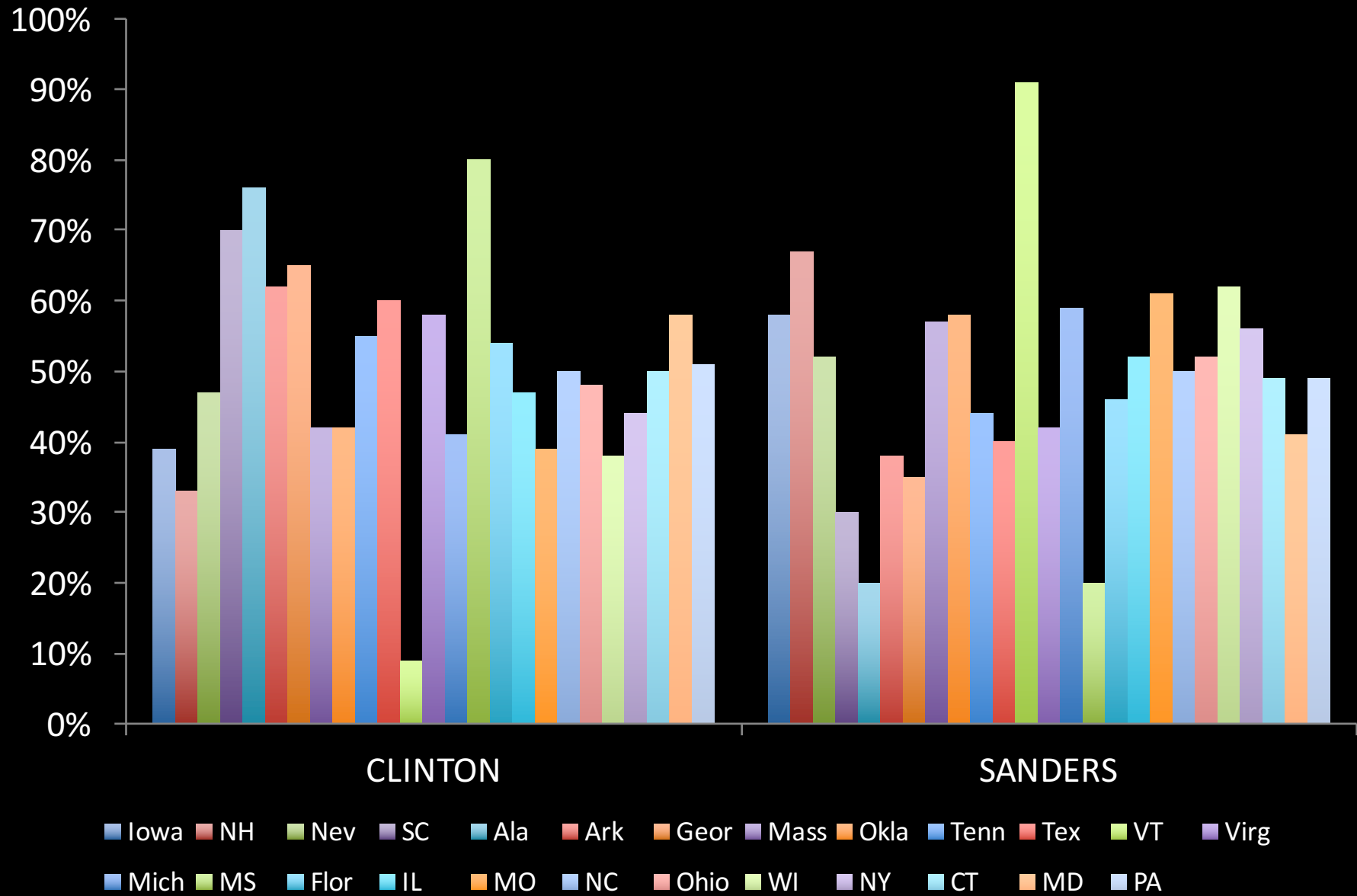


Candidate preference of Independents

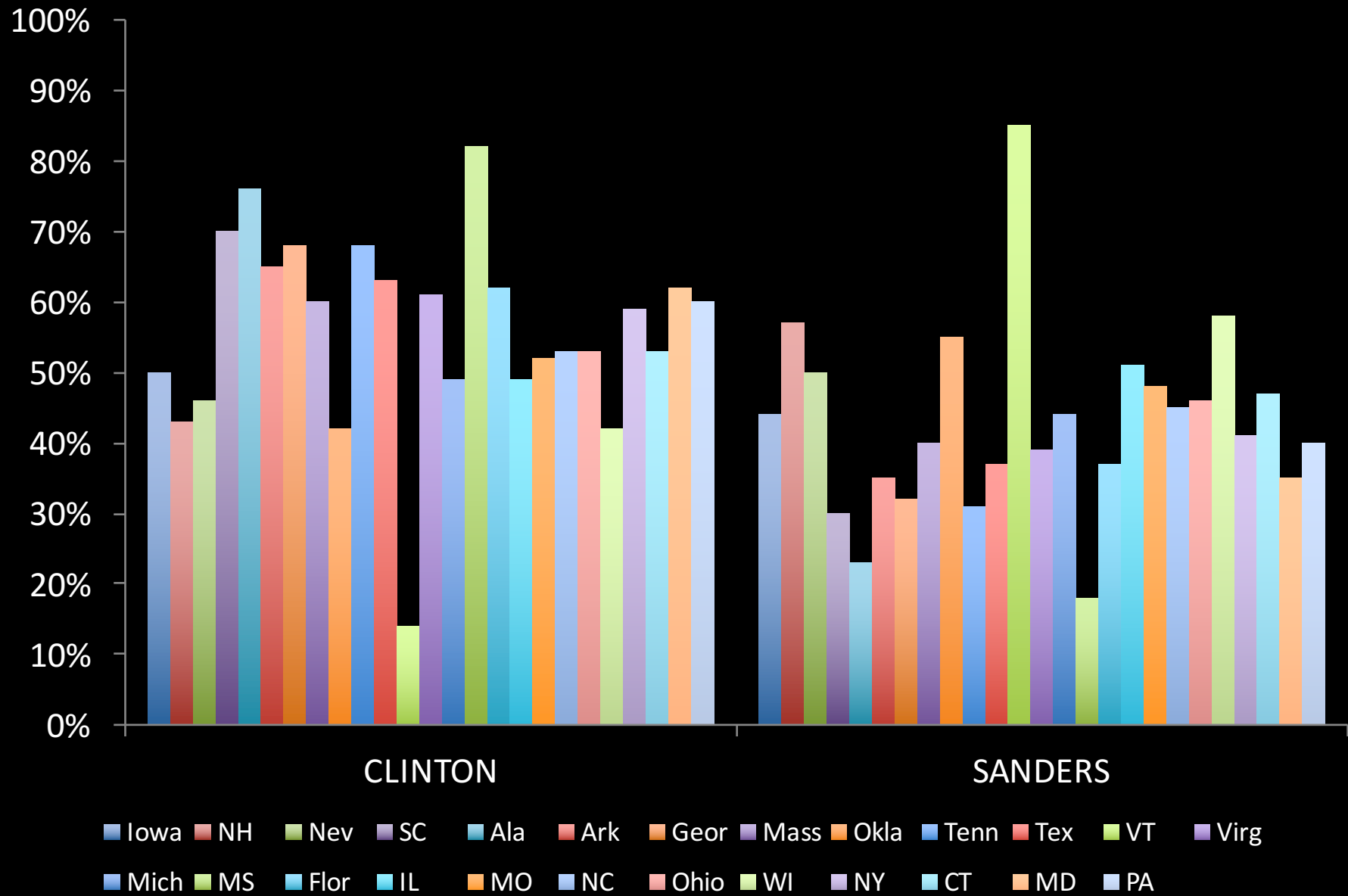




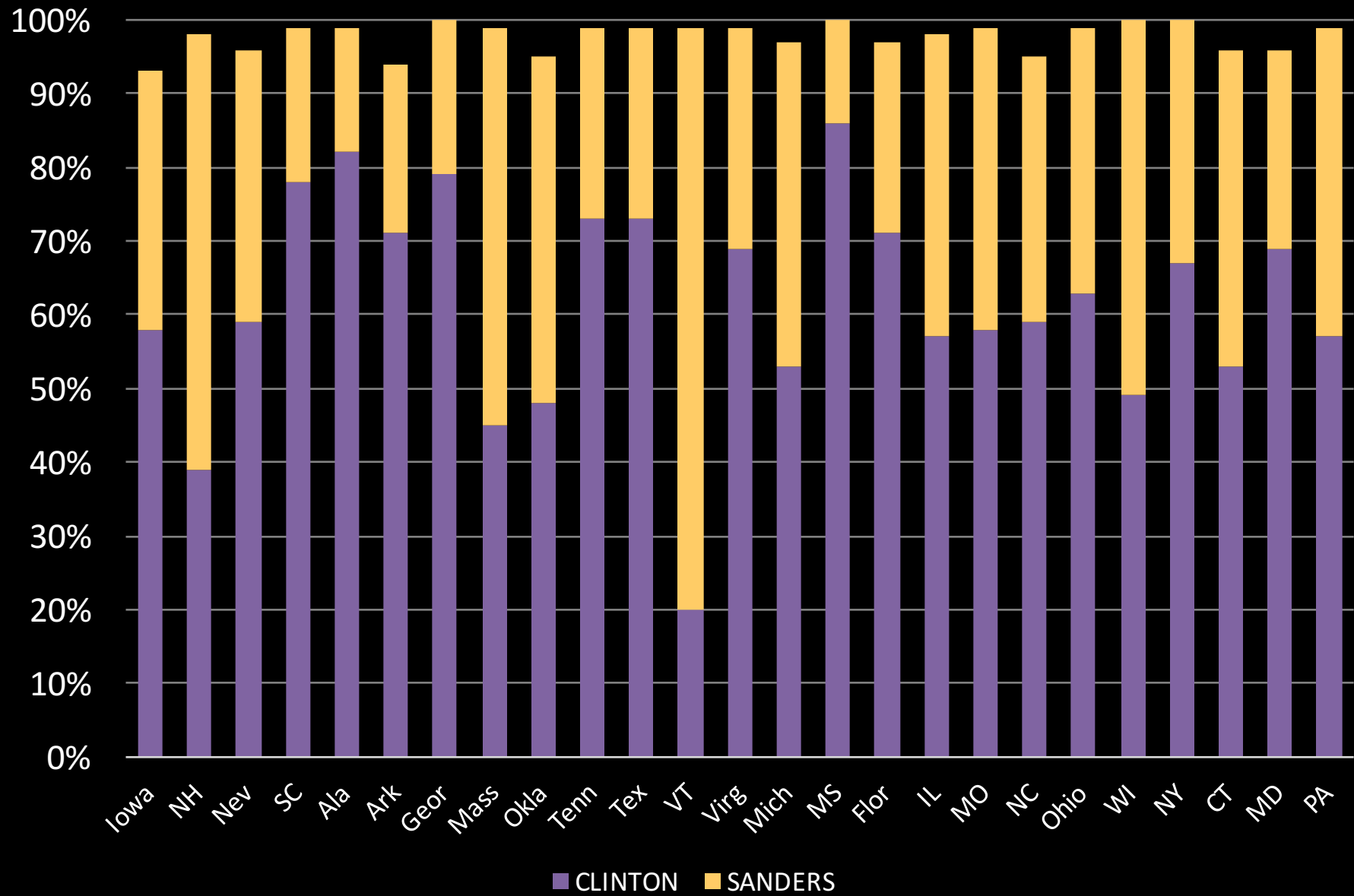
Candidate preference of "Very liberal" voters



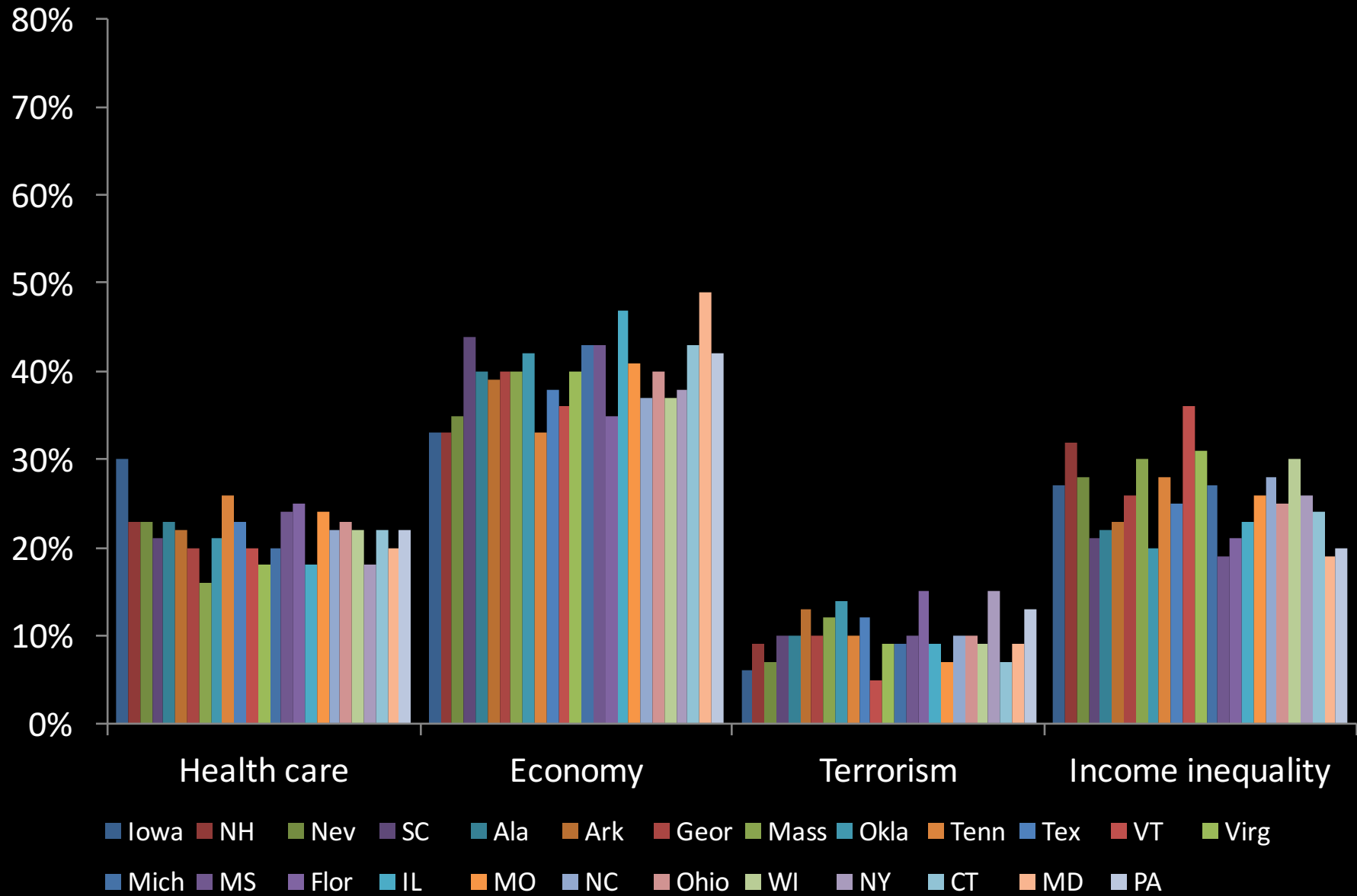
Candidate preference of "Somewhat liberal" voters



Candidate Choice of Self-Described Moderates

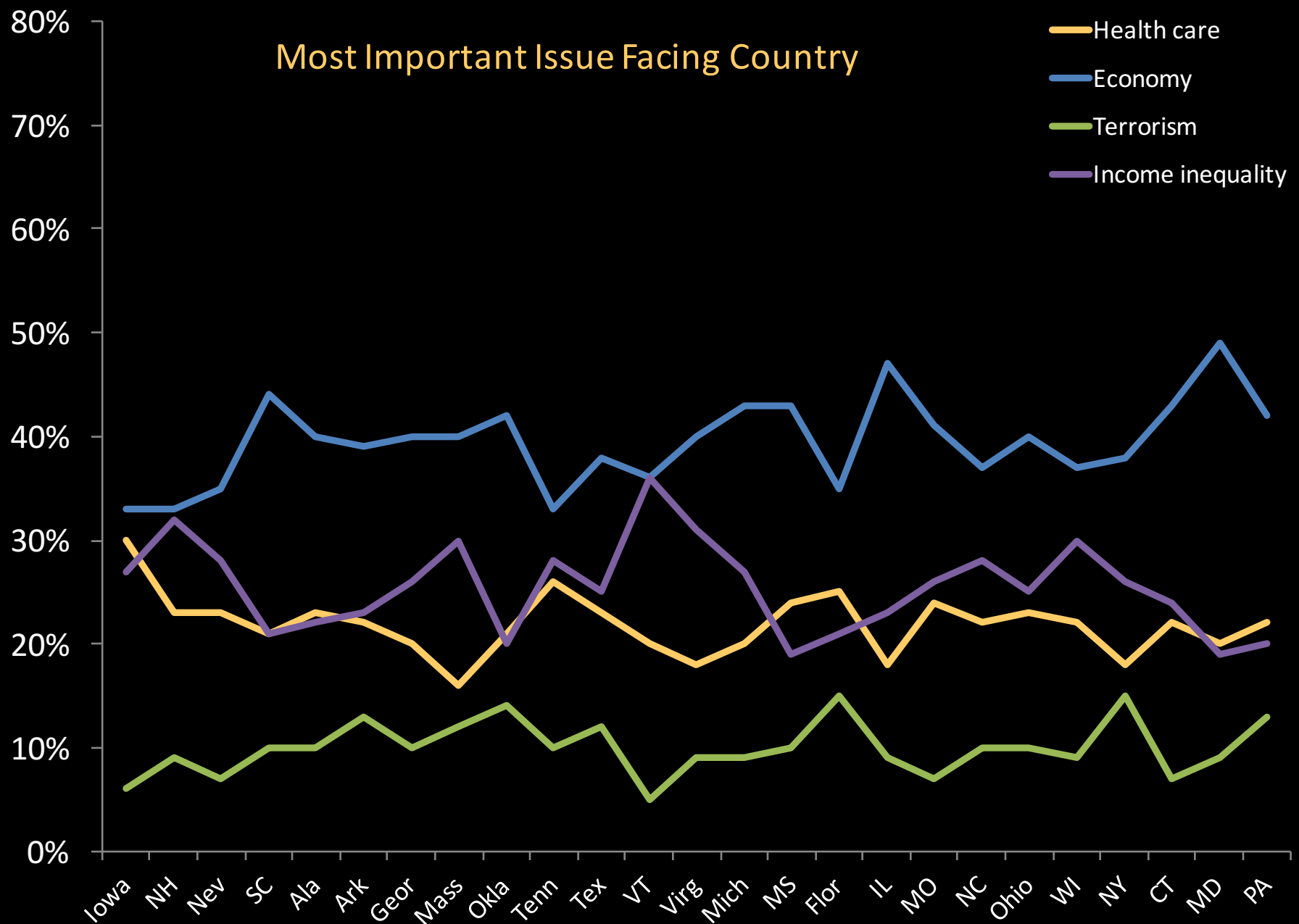

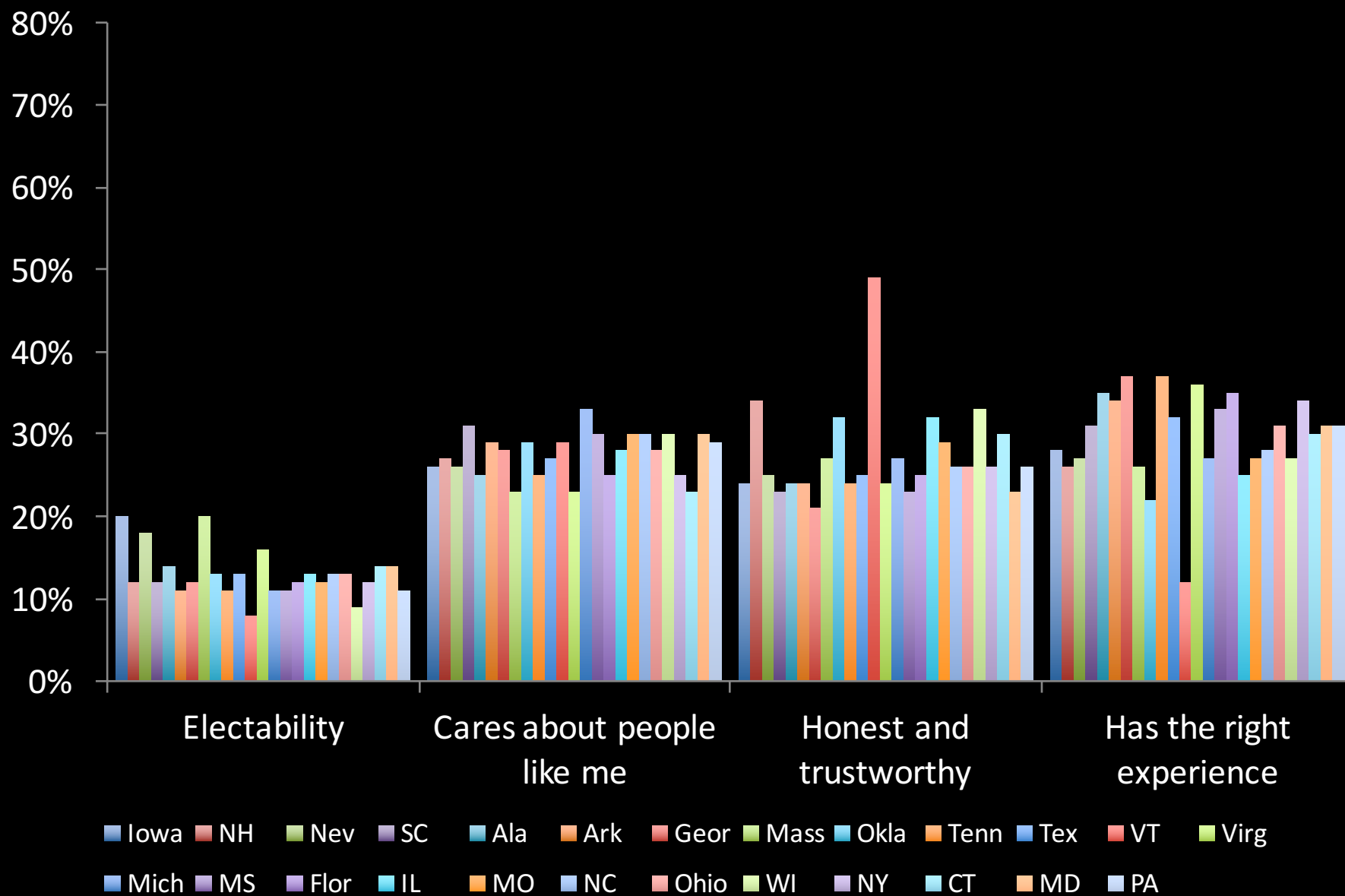

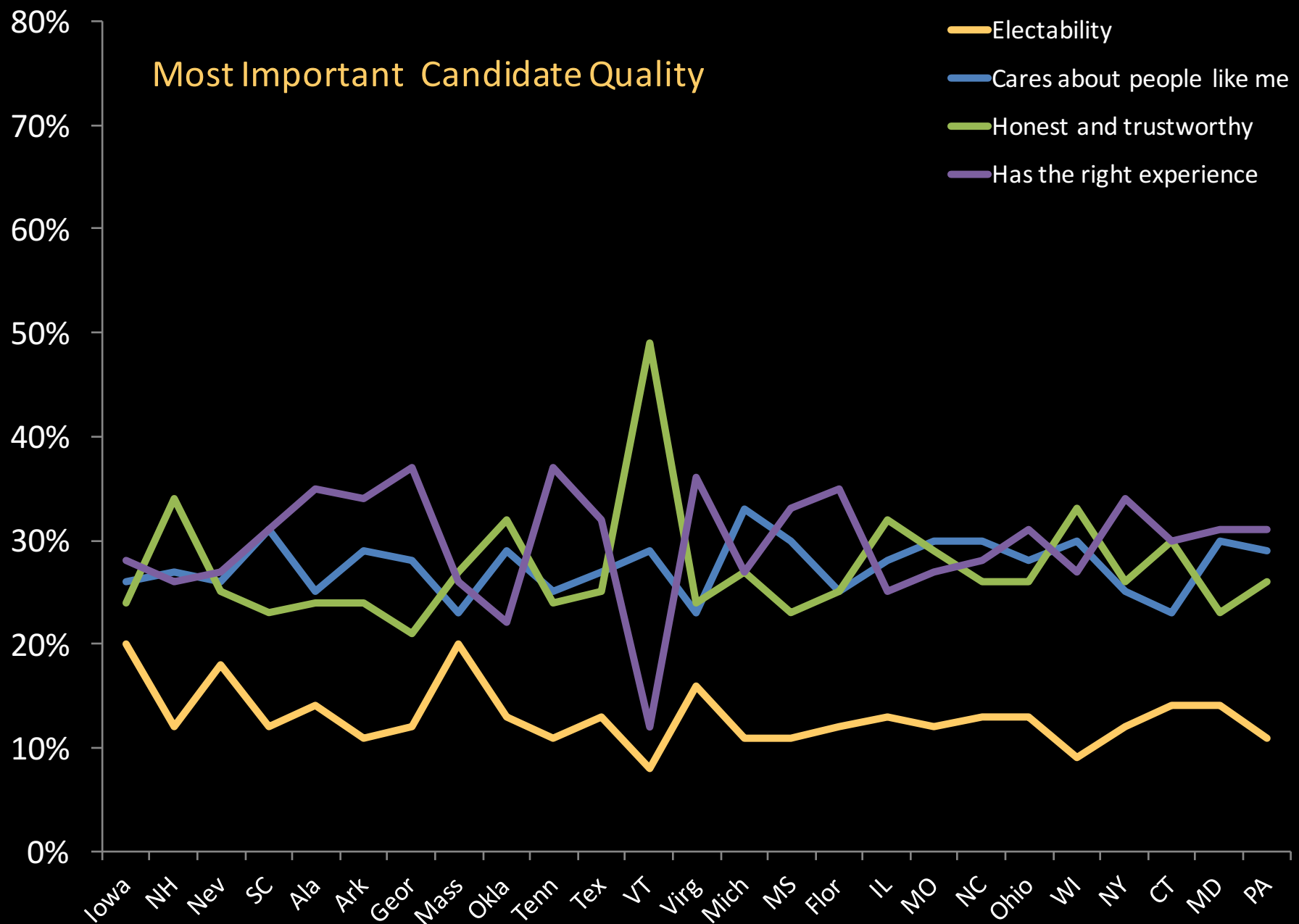
